Scholarships for KAPLAN Preparatory Courses are now available!!! We are able to offer scholarships for USMLE Step 1 and COMLEX Level 1 preparatory courses.

With the exception of members of the SNMA Board of Directors, all SNMA members may apply for the scholarships. There are a total of ten, each worth a maximum of \$1,000. Scholarship winners may select the program of their choice (i.e. live or self-study). Prepaid courses are not eligible, as no refunds will be issued.

The selection process will be based on the following:

1. Participation in SNMA and SNMA sponsored events
2. Participation in any other extracurricular activities

Applications must be accompanied by:

1. SNMA membership number
2. Letter of recommendation for SNMA activities. Letters will only be accepted from Regional Directors, Chapter Presidents or Chapter Advisors.
3. Letter of good standing from the Dean
4. Curriculum vitae
5. Academic transcript
6. Financial aid transcript
